## **WELCOME**

## TAPESTRY

Hopefully all our new starters have now had a chance to log on and have a look. Tapestry enables you to follow your child's individual progress closely and you can reflect upon their achievements with your child. You can add comments so that we as a staff find out about which activities your child really enjoyed and the learning they get up to at home. All of this information is stored on a highly secure server which is monitored closely. I cannot stress enough that Tapestry works at its best when it is a two-way communication. The children all absolutely love looking the photo's you as parents upload of the things you have been doing at home as a family. We get so much language and conversation from the children as they tell us what they have been doing; it's absolutely brilliant! And equally, for the children who cannot speak English this gives them the opportunity to share their experiences with us too. **So please, please, contribute to it as often as you can.** If you have any difficulties using it, just speak to us.

## LABELLING

We cannot *stress enough* the importance of you labelling **EVERYTHING** your child brings into playgroup please! When you are faced with 2 identical coats both aged 3 it is hard for the children and staff to know who they belong to. Please also label hats, cardigans, hoodies, lunchboxes etc. **We also have a few coats which have other children's names in them who don't actually attend the playgroup, please could you amend them?**

## INFORMATION FOLDER

This is kept on the table under the noticeboard; with lots of very useful guidance/leaflets for you.

## HONESTY LENDING LIBRARY

We have a box of books in the lobby which you are very welcome to borrow and share at home with your child, just help yourself. Please remember to return them when you have finished so that other children can borrow them.

## DUAL LANGUAGE BOOKS FOR SHARING

Please do not forget we have a wide range of Dual Language books that you can now borrow from playgroup to share with your child. A list is displayed on the notice board. Please speak to the ladies if you require any further information or would like to borrow one.

## OPEN DOOR POLICY

Please remember that we have an open door policy, this means if you have any questions, concerns or queries, please just come and speak to one of the ladies. We are here to help! **If you need to talk to a member of staff at letting out time, we would respectfully ask that you wait until she has finished calling the children.**

## IMPORTANT - SHOW & TELL

**Show and Tell days are Tuesdays and Thursdays.**

We teach the 'phonic' sound of each letter, not the letter name, for example, if you are bringing something for the sound "a" then an apple would be suitable but an aeroplane would not. Similarly, for "i" an igloo is great but an iron isn't.

PLEASE TAKE TIME TO FIND SOMETHING AT HOME WHICH RELATES TO THESE ONLY.

**For example, in the second week please bring in something which either begins with a or is blue - or be super clever and bring in something which is both!**

*Show and tell is a very important part of your child's development as it encourages:*

**\*Good listening skills\*      \*Turn taking\*      \*Self-confidence\***  
**\*Speaking in groups\*      \*Awareness of self and others\***
